It is also preferred that applicants gain experience that will prepare them for working with the culturally and linguistically diverse student population of the Bay Area; thus, applicants might want to consider seeking opportunities to work with students from backgrounds different from their own. In addition to volunteer positions offered by public school districts, applicants might want to consider opportunities to work with children or youth in after-school programs, religious or other community-based organizations, museums, sports teams, and summer camps.
