The term "weapon" refers to any instrument or device that has the potential for harm and is presented in a threatening manner.
6. Perjury, defined as willfully attesting, before the ASMC Judicial Board, to the truth of a material matter known to be false.
7. Any violation of published regulations of Mills College, including residence hall policies. It is the responsibility of each Mills student to be aware of the regulations that apply them. Such Mills College policies can be found in the College Catalog, the Student Handbook, and the memoranda of college policies, (which are distributed periodically by the administrative offices) all of which are available upon request.
8. All members of the Mills community and their guests are expected to behave courteously and respectfully to all persons regardless of their race, color, ethnicity, sex, sexual orientation, age, marital status, physical ability, religious beliefs, or political affiliation.
