

GUIDELINES FOR JUNIOR TRANSFER STUDENTS MAJORING IN STUDIO ART

The Studio Art Major requires a total of 15.25 semester course credits. At least 7.25 course credits must be taken at Mills (see below). The Art Department highly recommends that students majoring in Studio Art enroll for four semesters. If, however, students wish to complete their Studio Art major in three semesters, we recommend they begin in the spring semester (see below).

Required of all transfer students, majoring in Studio Art:

6 studio art courses to be taken at Mills, select from the following areas:

- Advanced Drawing
- Ceramics
- Electronic Arts
- Painting
- Photography
- Sculpture
- Video

Senior Requirement (1.25):

- ArtS 189 Senior Seminar (1), Fall, only
- ArtS 190 Senior Exhibition (.25), Spring, only

In addition transfer students must fulfill all the following courses required to complete the Studio Art major (which may be transferred from other institutions, or taken at Mills):

- Arth 018 Introduction to Western Art (1)
- Arth 019 Art of the Modern World (1)
- Arth 137 Art of the 20th Century (1) or Arth 138 Contemporary Art
- ArtS 005 (105) Basic Composition (1)
- ArtS 007 (107) Three-Dimensional Concepts (1)

And 3 additional credits in Studio Art or Art History (transferred or taken at Mills).

GUIDELINES FOR JUNIOR TRANSFER STUDENTS (3 semester plan)

We recommend beginning in the spring with two of the required six studio art courses. If students have not fulfilled the required Art History courses, they should do so in their first semester. In the fall students must register for ArtS 189 Senior Seminar (1), as well as taking two more of the six required studio art courses. In the third semester, students must register for ArtS 190 Senior Exhibition (.25) and the last two required Studio Art courses. In addition to these required courses in the Studio Art major, students must also fulfill all the College requirements for the BA degree (see the Mills Undergraduate Catalog).
